We are pleased to announce the 2025 Frozen Mint City Invitational scheduled for Saturday, February 1, 2025 at the St. Johns High School pool in St. Johns, MI. Detailed information and entry forms are enclosed. Please note entries are due by **Monday**, **January 27**.

There are a number of things we want coaches, parents, and swimmers to know in advance of the meet so it can run as smoothly as possible and be fun for everyone. We ask for your cooperation in enforcing the following:

1. Swimmers should remain in the designated areas in the building unless accompanied by a parent or coach. Footwear is required in all areas other than the pool deck.

2. Only swimmers, coaches, and authorized personnel will be allowed on the pool deck during the meet.

3. All concessions should remain in the areas designated. Please – no food on the pool deck. We may pass out candy to heat winners, please have kids throw wrappers in trash, not on the floor. Water (in non-glass bottles) is fine.

4. Please do not leave valuables unattended or unlocked. St. Johns Sea Lions and St. Johns High School are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

5. Awards will be given to the coaches at the end of the meet.

6. The morning session will have a supervised marshalling area. The afternoon session will be self-marshaled.

7. Relays may be mixed.

Time:	8:45 a.m. Warm-up 10 & Under 9:30 a.m. Start 12:00 p.m.* Warm-up 11 & Over 12:45 p.m. Start *This time may be adjusted slightly in the week prior to the meet, once all swimmers are registered. See website for final afternoon start time. sjsealions.com		
Rules:	Meet will follow MTSL Rules of Operation. The no-false-start rule will be in effect. Swimmers are to swim the age they will be on February 1, 2025.		
Awards:	Trophies for 1 <sup>st</sup> place, medals with lanyards for 2 <sup>nd</sup> through 3 <sup>rd</sup> place, and ribbons for 4 <sup>th</sup> through 12 <sup>th</sup> place. Relays will receive medals for 1 <sup>st</sup> place, and ribbons for 2 <sup>nd</sup> through 6 <sup>th</sup> place. Awards will be given to the coaches at the end of the meet.		
Entry Fee:	\$6.00 per individual event, \$16.00 per relay. Swimmers may swim up to a maximum of five events: three individual and two relay. We request that each team provide only one check covering the total amount for that team prior to the meet. <b>Please make checks payable to St. Johns Sea Lions.</b> No deck entries will be allowed.		
Entry Deadline:	The entry chairperson must receive entries no later than Tuesday at 11:59 p.m., <b>January 28, 2025.</b> E-mail entries in Hy-Tek or text format will be acknowledged by e-mail upon receipt.

**From the north:** take US 127 to the first St. Johns exit, which is Business 27. Proceed south to M-21 and turn right (west). Drive past the courthouse and turn left (south) at the blinker light (Lansing Street). Turn right on Sickels, and the high school parking lot is directly west of the high school. The pool is on the west side of the school.

**From the south:** take US 127 to the second St. Johns exit (M-21). Turn left (west) on M-21 and continue west through the intersection of M-21 and Business 27. Drive past the courthouse and turn left (south) at the blinker light (Lansing Street). Turn right on Sickels, and the high school parking lot is directly west of the high school. The pool is on the west side of the school.

**From the west:** take M-21 into St. Johns and turn right (south) at the blinker light (Lansing Street). Turn right on Sickels, and the high school parking lot is directly west of the high school. The pool is on the west side of the school.

**From the east:** take M-21 into St. Johns. Continue west through the intersection of M-21 and Business 27. Drive past the courthouse and turn left (south) at the blinker light (Lansing Street). Turn right on Sickels, and the high school parking lot is directly west of the high school. The pool is on the west side of the school.
